

What is Home Based Primary Care?

- Home Based Primary Care is health care services provided to patients in their home.
- A VA doctor directs the health care team who provides the care.
- HBPC is for patients with health problems that make it hard to use the VA Primary Care Clinics.
- Most health care can take place in the home such as check-ups, teaching, getting samples for labs and managing the patient's medication.
- HBPC is a team of experts trained to provide the best possible care for patients at home.

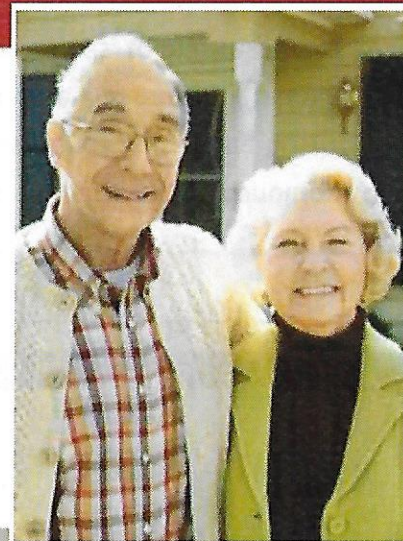
