How can I get home care?

The home care program is available to veterans who are eligible to receive care at Central Texas VA. You must live within approximately 50 miles of the VA or nearest VA outpatient clinic and have a relative or friend who can help with the home care (only if you cannot manage alone). The HBPC team will come to your home to talk with you and your family to see if you are a good match for the program. The charge for the program depends on your individual VA eligibility.

To start the homecare process you can talk to your regular doctor or give us a call. Once we hear from you, a member from our team will come to your home to give you an overview of our program and together, we will work to match your needs.
